INSTRUCTION GUIDE

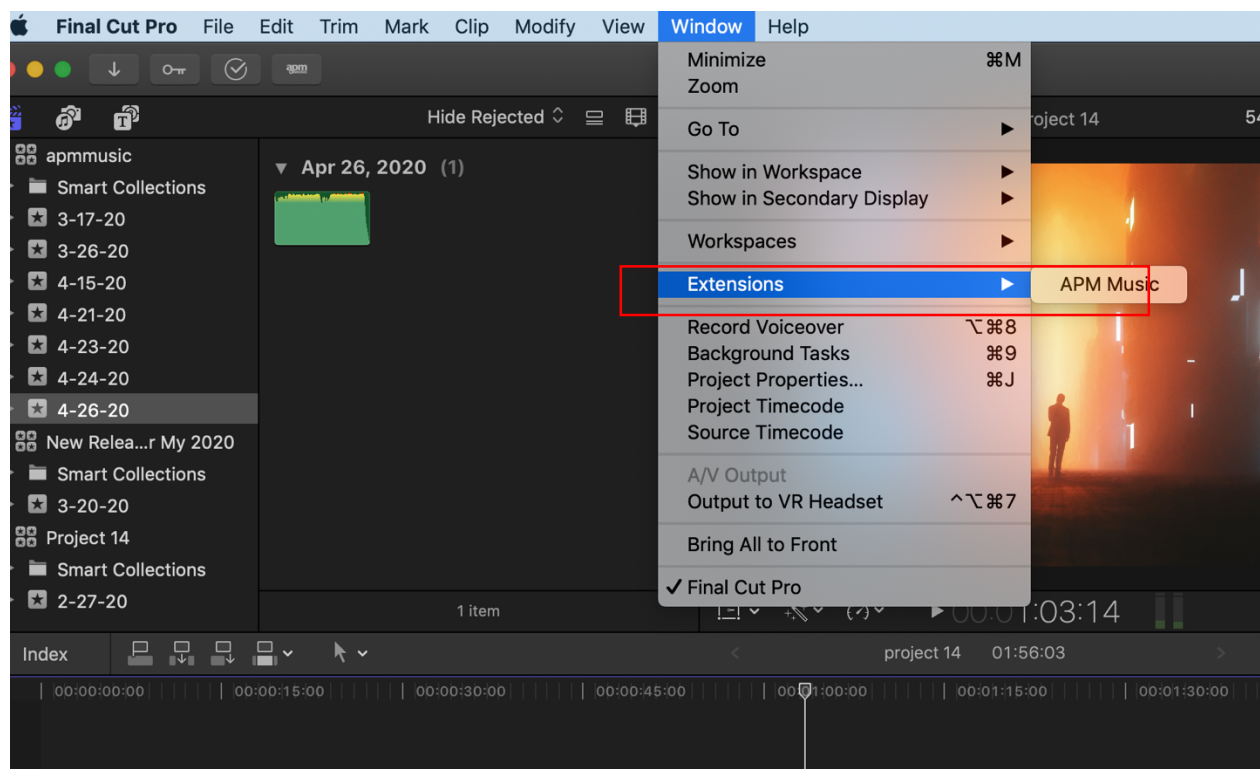
Requirements:

OSX 10.13.6 or later

Final Cut Pro X 10.4.4 or later

USING THE EXTENSION

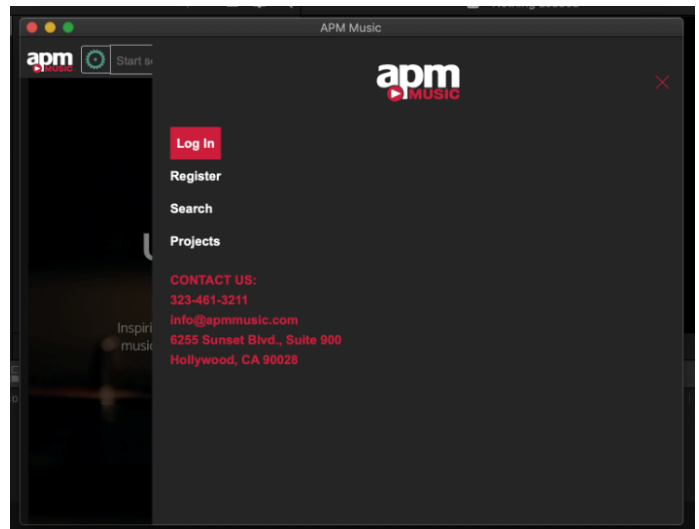
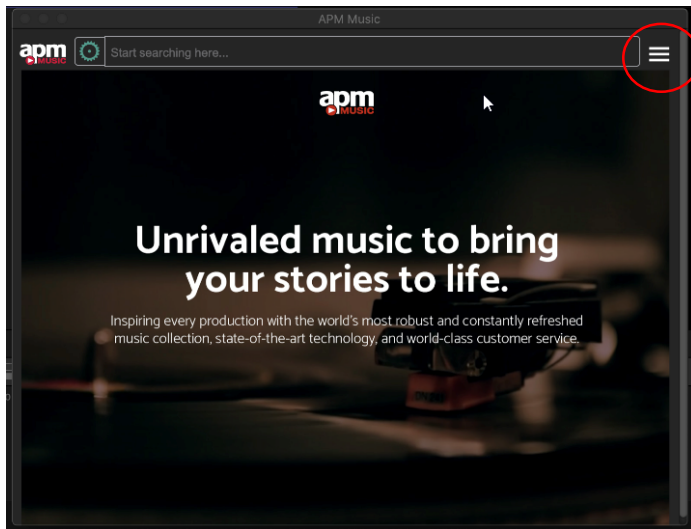
1. Open **Final Cut Pro X (FCP)**
2. Go to Window > Extensions and you will see your **APM Music** extension, now available for use
3. Click on **APM Music** to open the APM Music search site within FCP



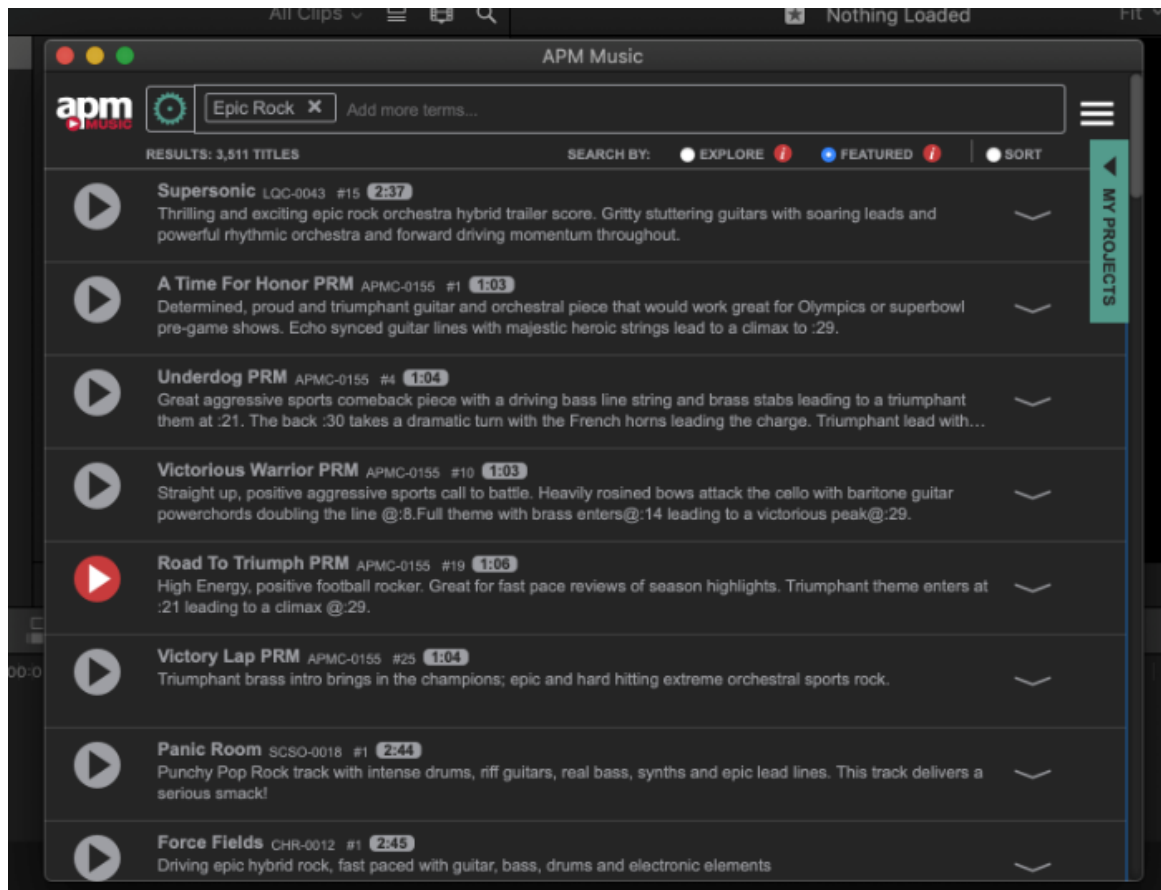
4. Once the extension is available, **log into your APM Music search account** by clicking on the hamburger



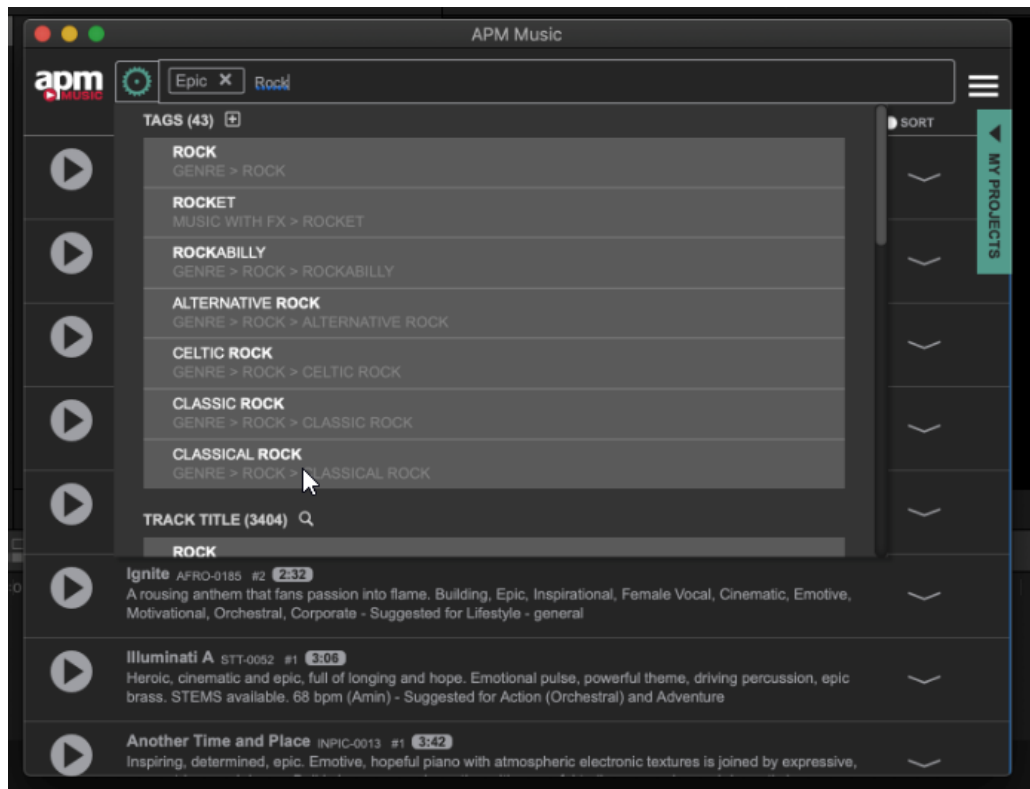
top right and clicking the red “Log In” button.



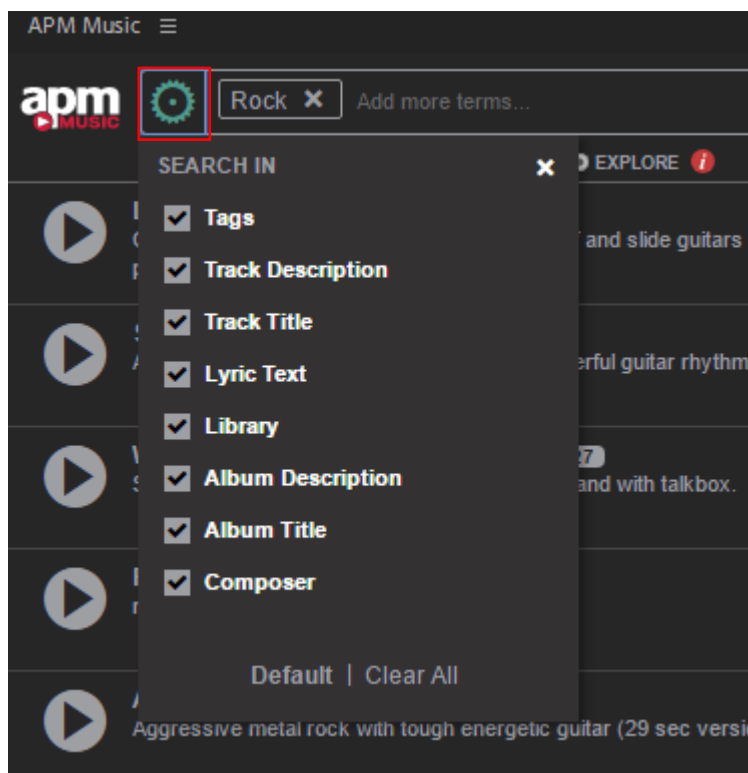
5. Once logged in, you can **search for music** to import into your FCP sessions



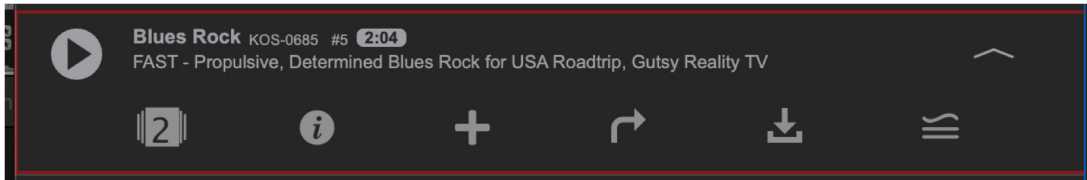
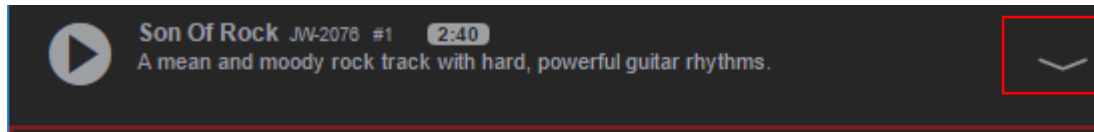
6. Search for music by typing into the predictive search box



7. Change your search filters by clicking on the gear to the left of the search box



8. Access track actions icons by clicking on the down arrow to the right of any track.



Track actions (from left to right) include:

1. **Alternate versions** – Click to see all versions of main track
2. **Access track metadata** – View metadata for selected track
3. **Add to project** – Add this track to folders in your MY PROJECTS area
4. **Send** – Send this track to a colleague
5. **Download into FCP project** – Download this track directly to your libraries sidebar
6. **More like this** – Returns similar tracks based on track metadata

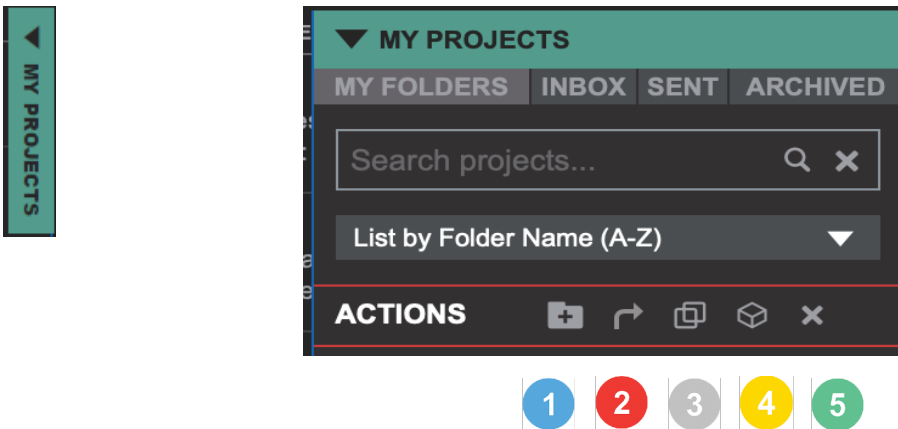
9. Audition any track by clicking the play button next to the track.



10. Scrub through the audio waveform in the footer player. (This appears once you click play on any track.)




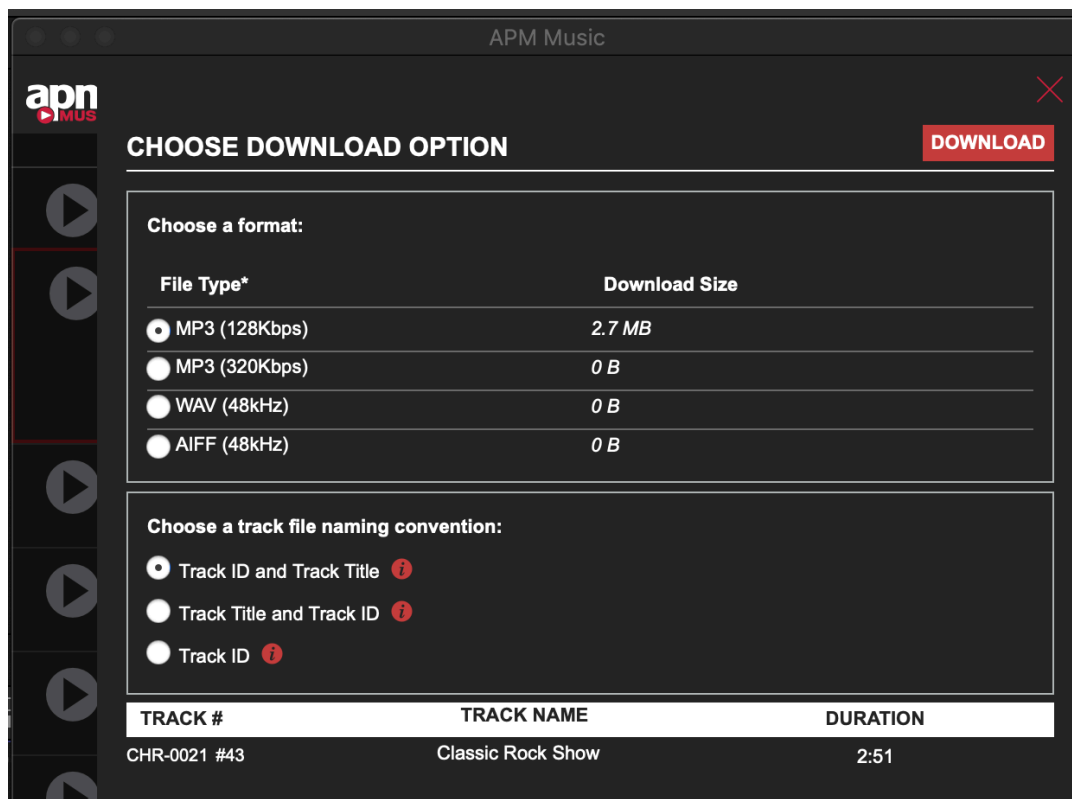
11. Access your projects at any time by clicking on the “MY PROJECTS” panel. This will open your projects giving you access to all projects functionality.



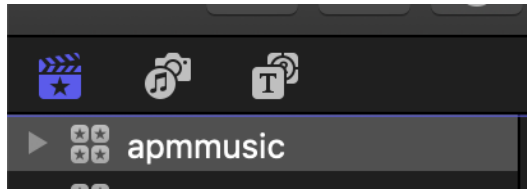
Projects actions (from left to right) include:

1. **Create new project** – Click to create a new project or sub-project
2. **Share** – Click to share selected project
3. **Copy to my folder** – Click to make a copy of selected project. (copy appears in MY FOLDERS tab)
4. **Archive** – Click to archive project. (Archived project appears in ARCHIVED tab)
5. **Delete** – Click to delete selected project.

12. Select the track you would like to import into your session(s) and click the **download button** . This will open the download options dialog box.

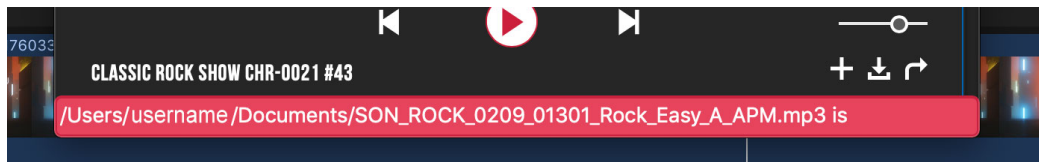


13. From within the download dialog box, **choose your file type** and **file naming convention**, then select **“Download”** and your selection will be placed into your apmmusic folder in your libraries sidebar where you can pull it into your projects. **Note:** If this is your first download, an apmmusic folder will automatically be created and placed into your libraries sidebar.

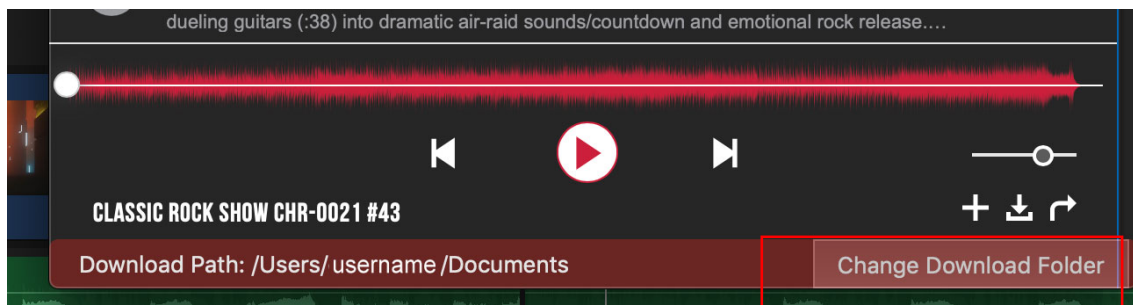


14. Setting and re-setting download location preference

Whenever you download a track to your project, you will see the progress bar and download location at the bottom of the plugin.



When you hover over the bottom of the plugin, you will see the download path, and you can change the download location by clicking on “Change Download Folder” and setting the desired location.
